Welcome! We are so glad each of you has chosen to worship with us!

If you are a first-time or returning guest, we invite you to fill out a "Connection Card" located in the hymnal rack on the back of the pew. Please take your completed card to the *Connection Center* in the main foyer. We have some gifts for you!

Members and regular attenders need not fill out cards unless you have prayer requests and other information. You may drop these in the offering plates at the back of the Worship Center.

The Lord's Supper: Jesus gave us this memorial to call our attention each week to the price He paid for our sins - death on a cross, burial and conquering the grave through His resurrection. All believers are invited to participate. You may partake of the bread and the cup when you are ready, then place the cup in the holder in front of you. Use this time for your own personal prayer and meditation.

Baptism: You may witness a baptism today. This great event is part of a person's decision to commit his/her life to Christ (Acts 2:38, 39). Immersion in water in the name of Christ is the God-given occasion at which, through faith, a person comes in contact with the death and resurrection of Christ (Romans 6:1-4; Colossians 2:9-12). Baptism pictures the death and burial of our old life without God and the beginning of a new life as a follower of Christ.

For those with children: Jesus set an example for us when He welcomed children to come to Him, so we have prepared a special place for children at Woodlawn. Please consider allowing your children to participate in our nursery and children's programs. We offer a well-supervised, nurturing atmosphere and activities designed to meet children's needs. We offer care for infants and toddlers under age two at both **9:30** and **10:45** in rooms B-115, 116. Sunday School classes are offered for all ages of children and youth through grade 12 at **9:30**. There are extended sessions for preschoolers. **TODAY IS FAMILY DAY.** Elementary age children (K-5th Grade) will worship with their parents at **10:45**.
